Dear Dr. Bastow:

In letter received January 20, 2016, (ML16019A152, including attachments), you contacted the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission and indicated that you wished to terminate your NRC License No. 21-32316-01. In your letter, you confirmed that all residual licensed material has been removed from the Cardiology II, P.C. location of use – 950 Blue Star Highway, Suite 1-2, South Haven, Michigan, listed on the referenced Bradley D. Bastow, D.O. license – such that any remaining residual radioactivity is within the limits of 10 CFR Part 20, Subpart E, and is ALARA.

Based on its review, the staff has concluded that all licensable radioactive material has been removed from the Bradley D. Bastow, D.O. facilities located at 950 Blue-Star Highway, Suite 1-2, South Haven, Michigan and residual radioactive material attributable to licensed activities does not exceed current NRC criteria. Based on these conclusions no further remediation or actions with respect to NRC regulated material is required. Your facilities are suitable for unrestricted use and NRC license number 21-32316-01 is hereby terminated.
