From January 12-14, 2016, the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) conducted a security inspection at your Research Reactor facility (Inspection Report. No. 50-170/2016-201). The inspection included a review of activities authorized for your facility.

The inspection examined activities conducted under your license as they relate to security and compliance with the Commission's rules and regulations, and compliance with the conditions of your license. The inspector reviewed selected procedures and records, observed activities, and interviewed personnel. Based on the results of this inspection, no findings of significance were identified. No response to this letter is required.
