NOTIFICATIONS

A BCS'15 report, dated May 19, 2015, by NRC staff requested Commission approval to discontinue the 10 CFR Part 26, Subpart 1, licensing activity. The report requested that the Commission approve the petition (QC) with the following conditions: (1) the Commission must be satisfied that the petition is in the public interest; (2) the Commission must be satisfied that the petition is in the public interest; (3) the Commission must be satisfied that the petition is in the public interest; (4) the Commission must be satisfied that the petition is in the public interest. This document is publicly available at Agencywide Document Access and Management System (ADAMS) Accession No. N15-0196-001.

The Commission's staff requirements memorandum (SRM) to SECY-15-0074, approved the staff's request to discontinue the QC-QV rulemaking activity and directed the staff to address in a separate action the three positions for rulemaking (PRMs) (i.e., PRM-26-5, PRM-26-6, and PRM-26-4) that were also to have been considered in the rulemaking. On December 9, 2015, the rulemaking discontinuation notice was published in the Federal Register.
