Dear Mr. Falce,

This is in reference to your application dated January 19, 2016, requesting for renewal to Nuclear Regulatory Commission License No. 06-28529-01, Docket No. 03031720. In order to continue our review, we need the following additional information:

1. Your application should have been signed by a management representative rather than the Radiation Safety Officer. Please submit a letter signed by a management representative indicating that management has reviewed the application and concurs in the statements and representations contained therein. Currently we have Mr. Brian Fitzpatrick, Corporate Director, Health & Safety as your designated management representative. Note also that a management representative should sign all future correspondence that requests a change in your license.
2. Your application did not request the amounts of material you would like to be licensed. NRC Licenses required limits on the quantity to be licensed for on each isotope. Please state the maximum possession limit you desire for each isotope.
3. NUREG-1556, Volume 1, Revision 1, "Consolidated Guidance About Materials Licenses: Program-Specific Guidance About Portable Gauge Licenses," provides the guidance for portable gauge licenses. An Errata was made in July 5, 2005 (<http://pbadupws.nrc.gov/docs/ML0521/ML052130055.pdf>) providing security guidance on portable gauges. Please state, "Security procedures will be developed, implemented, and maintained and will meet the criteria in the Errata dated July 5, 2005, 'Appendix H- Operating and Emergency Procedures.'"

We will continue our review upon receipt of this information. Please reply to my attention at the Region 1 Office (Address below) and refer to Mail Control No. 590037. If you have technical questions regarding this letter, please call me at (610) 337-5366.

Your reply must be an originally signed and dated letter. The letter may be scanned and submitted as a pdf document attached to an email; or it may be transmitted by facsimile to (610) 337-5269; or it may be sent by regular mail. If we do not receive a reply from you within 30 calendar days from the date of this e-mail, we will assume that you do not wish to pursue your application or amendment request.
