Dear Mr. Chambers:

Enclosed is a corrected copy for Amendment No. 09 to your NRC Material License No. 24-32591-01. The changes made to your license are printed in **bold font**. It has come to our attention that errors existed in Amendment No. 09, issued August 7, 2015. Please note that, as discussed in our telephone conversation on February 5, 2016, we have corrected the following license items:

1. Subitems 6.A., 6.D., and 8.D. have been changed to reflect the type of byproduct material, authorized use of licensed material and possession limit requested in your letter dated May 19, 2015;
2. Subitem 9, (authorized use), License Condition 10, (location of use), License Condition 11, (decommissioning financial assurance), License Condition 13, (decommissioning report/plan), and License Condition 14, (licensee/customer written agreement) were updated to reflect current NRC policy and language; and
3. License Condition 16, (leak test), Licensed Condition 17, (sealed sources), License Condition 18 (inventory), and Licensed Condition 19, (transportation) were added to the license. These license conditions were inadvertently removed from the license with the issuance of License Amendment No. 09.

We apologize for any inconvenience these errors may have caused.

Please review the enclosed document *carefully* and be sure that you understand all conditions. If there are any errors or questions, please notify the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission, Region III office at (630) 829-9887 so that we can provide appropriate corrections and answers.
