Dear Mr. Gorecki,

I've reviewed your exempt distribution report dated January 8, 2016 and there are two issues that should be addressed so that your report meets the reporting requirements.

Your report indicates that your products were transferred for use under 10 CFR 40.13 2(c)(1)(iii). This reference was apparently copied from Condition 9 of your license; however, this reference was incorrectly written in your license when it was issued. To address this issue, a corrected copy of your license was issued on February 4, 2016 with the correct reference, i.e., 10 CFR 40.13(c)(1)(ii). The corrected copy of your license and cover letter are attached to this email. Please revise and resubmit your report to include the correct regulatory reference. Also, your report only listed the activity/item and did not provide the total quantity of source material for each product. Please revise your report to explicitly state, for each type of product and each model number, the total quantity of the source material. Further information about the requirements that apply to annual reports of exempt distribution can be found in the attached Regulatory Issue Summary.
