That said, there a few facilities specifically licensed for Low Level Waste (LL W) storage by agreement states- e.g. WCS in Texas, Energy Solutions in SC and TN. NRC regulations do not require licensees to differentiate between radioactive material and LL W, there are likely dozens to hundreds of ad hoc LL W "storage" facilities at any given time.

You may also find the entire list of ISFSI (independent spent fuel storage installation) in public ADAMS under ML15240A058. Of those sites, only 2 are not spent fuel, which are Private Fuel Storage and the DOE Idaho Spent Fuel Storage Facility, both of which are specific licensed ISFSIs.
