Dear Ms. Jenny,

The U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) staff performed an acceptance review of your letter dated November 20, 2015 (GLE-2015-0157), submitting, pursuant to Title 10 of the *Code of Federal Regulations* (10 CFR) 95.17(a)(1), Global Laser Enrichment, LLC's (GLE's), amendment nineteenth to its original foreign ownership, control, or influence (FOCI) information submittal supporting the NRC facility clearance (FCL) granted to GLE. In your letter, you stated that this amendment reflects organizational changes which are documented in the enclosed 4 Owner, Officers, Directors, and Executive Personnel (OODEP) lists: 1 for GLE, and 3 submitted on behalf of its parent company GE Hitachi Nuclear Energy Americas, LLC (GEHA), which also has a non-possessing FCL granted by the NRC.

The NRC staff found your submittal acceptable for further review. The Cost Activity Code (CAC) number for this licensing action is **L34344, Submittal of FOCI Information Amendment for GLE**. Under our metrics system, the NRC has up to **150 days** to review your request after it has been accepted. As such, NRC's review of your request is to be completed by not later than **July 8, 2016**.
