Dear Dr. Harvey,

I've reviewed your exempt distribution report dated January 28, 2016 for the 2015 reporting period.

In your report you indicated that each device contains a maximum activity of 10 mCi per source of Ni-63. The regulations in 10 CFR 32.29(c) require you to report the actual amounts of radioactive material transferred and not the maximum amount. Also, you did not indicate the total quantity of radioactive material that was transferred, you only indicated the maximum amount that may be included in an individual device. Please revise and resubmit your report to indicate the total quantity of Ni-63 that was transferred for each type of product and each model number, as required by 10 CFR 32.29(c)(3)(ii). Further information about the requirements that apply to annual reports of exempt distribution can be found in the attached Regulatory Issue Summary.
