Request to Consolidate 10 CFR Part 71 Quality Assurance Program Approvals for Radioactive Material Packages at Exelon Generation Company, LLC Nuclear Power Plants

In Reference 1, the NRC transmitted a revised 10 CFR Part 71 Quality Assurance Program Approval (i.e., NRC Form 311, "Quality Assurance Program Approval for Radioactive Material Packages) for radioactive materials packages (i.e., No. 0008, Revision 12) at the following Exelon Generation Company, LLC (EGC) nuclear stations, on NRC Docket No. 71-0008:

- Braidwood Station, Units 1 and 2
- Byron Station, Units 1 and 2
- Clinton Power Station, Unit 1
- Dresden Nuclear Power Station, Units 1, 2, and 3
- LaSalle County Station, Units 1 and 2
- Limerick Generating Station, Units 1 and 2
- Oyster Creek Generating Station
- Peach Bottom Atomic Power Station, Units 1, 2, and 3
- Quad Cities Nuclear Power Station, Units 1 and 2
- Three Mile Island Station, Unit 1

In References 2, 3, and 4, the U. S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) transmitted a revised 10 CFR Part 71 Quality Assurance Program Approval for radioactive materials packages at the following EGC nuclear stations and NRC Docket Nos., respectively:

- Approval No. 0019, Revision 9; Docket No. 71-0019;
   R.E. Ginna Nuclear Power Plant
- Approval No. 0045, Revision 8; Docket No. 71-0045;
   Nine Mile Point Nuclear Station, Units 1 and 2
- Approval No. 0383, Revision 8; Docket No. 71-0383;
   Calvert Cliffs Nuclear Power Plant, Units 1 and 2

In Reference 5, EGC transmitted a summary of changes to the 10 CFR Part 50 Exelon Quality Assurance Topical Report (QATR) that did not reduce commitments in the quality assurance program description, and therefore did not require NRC approval prior to implementation. EGC submitted this change summary in accordance with 10 CFR 71.106(b) for radioactive materials package Nos. 0008, 0019, 0045, and 0383, which collectively take credit for the 10 CFR Part 50 QATR to satisfy the Quality Assurance Program Requirements of 10 CFR 71.101(b) in accordance with 10 CFR 71.101(f).

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EGC requests that the individual 10 CFR Part 71 Quality Assurance Program Approval Nos. 0383, 0019, and 0045 be consolidated under 10 CFR Part 71 Quality Assurance Program Approval No. 0008 on Docket No. 71-0008, and that the three individual Quality Assurance Program Approval Nos. be terminated.

With respect to the consolidated Approval No. 0008, EGC requests the following changes to the associated NRC Form 311:

- 1) Revise Block 2, "Name" to state: "Exelon Generation Company, LLC"
- 2) Revise Item 4 in Block 5, "Conditions" to include:
  - Calvert Cliffs Nuclear Power Plant (Units 1 and 2)
  - R.E. Ginna Nuclear Power Plant
  - Nine Mile Point Nuclear Station (Units 1 and 2)

There are no regulatory commitments in this submittal.
