Quarterly Status Report for Technical Assistance Provided by the United States Department of Energy January 1 through March 31, 2014 2nd Quarter of Fiscal Year 2014

I. Introduction

The Department of Energy (DOE) and the Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) have entered into five interagency agreements for DOE to provide technical assistance in carrying out NRC's responsibilities with respect to classified matter protection programs at various licensee sites.
