This letter is written in response to your letter sent to us from September 30, 2015 please see the attached letter, in regards to a generally licensed devise we had in our possession. After receiving this letter, we contacted Hector Rodriguez-Luccioni. We were told by Mr. Rodriguez-Luccioni that according to his records we had a Static Eliminator model # PDM.1002H3 serial number 3692KB. He suggested we contact several companies who either created or installed this devise as we did not know what it was and where it was installed. We spoke to a Wayne London from either Amersham or GE, who stated the company is no longer in business and he would attempt to contact them for more information. We understand this was a devise installed in our body shop paint booths. In 2014 we tore down the paint booths and have added a whole new wing just for brand new paint booths. We also in 2012 changed over to water borne paint. Our current body shop manager did not know what the device was and does not know of its existence.
