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Dear Mr. Hecht,

I've reviewed your exempt distribution report dated January 25, 2016 for the 2015 reporting period.

Please revise and resubmit your report to indicate that the products were transferred for use under 10 CFR 30.15(a)(8)(iv) as required by 10 CFR 32.16(a)(2). Also, you have indicated that the maximum amount of radioactivity in each product is 10 uCi (0.37 MBq). The reporting requirements in 10 CFR 32.16 concerning the *actual* quantities of radioactive material in products that were distributed rather than the maximum that *could* be distributed. In the revision to your report, please indicate the actual quantities of radioactive material that were distributed in your products. Further information about the requirements that apply to annual reports of exempt distribution can be found in the attached Regulatory Issue Summary.
