**SUBJECT: RESPONSE TO NRC INSPECTION REPORT 030-32428/2015-001 AND
NOTICE OF VIOLATION**

Dear Mr. Davis:

On January 20, 2016, the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) cited Teton Nuclear Medicine Service, LLC for a violation of NRC requirements. Inspection Report 030-32428/2015-001 with enclosed Notice of Violation required you to respond in writing in 30 days. You responded by letter received by our office on February 16, 2016.

After reviewing the information you provided in your response to the Notice of Violation, we have concluded that your completed and proposed actions appear to adequately address the regulatory noncompliance described in the Notice of Violation. We will review your implementation of these corrective actions during a future inspection to determine whether full compliance has been restored and whether compliance will be maintained.
