SUBJECT: MEETING SUMMARY REGARDING PUBLIC CALL TO DISCUSS
CONCEPTS FOR THE PROPOSED CYBER SECURITY
RULEMAKING AT FUEL CYCLE FACILITIES HELD ON
FEBRUARY 18, 2016

The U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) staff held a public meeting conference call with the fuel cycle industry, the Nuclear Energy Institute, and members of the public on February 18, 2016, to discuss concepts for Fuel Cycle Cyber Security Proposed Rulemaking. A handout was provided which outlined the nine concepts envisioned for the proposed rulemaking, (Enclosure 3). The NRC staff discussed each of the nine concepts and received feedback from the stakeholders. The stakeholders were requested to provide input on topics that should be discussed at the next public meeting, scheduled for March 17, 2016. A number of issues were identified for future discussion including control sets, support systems, screening methodology for asset identification, periodic reviews/assessments timeline, lessons learned from reactor cyber security rulemaking, and comment resolution on the regulatory basis.
