Dear Mr. Kruger:

The purpose of this letter is to acknowledge receipt of your letter dated January 20, 2012, which described the actions that Kruger Technologies, Inc. has completed in response to the Confirmatory Order issued to you by the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) on October 28, 2014. We have completed our review of the actions described in your letter, which appear to be adequate, and have no further questions at this time. We recognize that you self-identified a violation of minor safety significance to meet the requirements of the Order regarding the timeliness of the Radiation Safety Officer training for the individual at your Knob Noster, Missouri facility, which was supposed to be completed by December 1, 2015. We recognize that the availability of training is something that is outside of your control, and we appreciate your efforts in ensuring that the training is completed as soon as possible in order to complete the requirements of the Order. We understand, based on your letter, that the individual is scheduled to attend an in-person training on February 18, 2016. For future occurrences where you may not be able to meet the timeliness requirements of the Order, we would appreciate your bringing this to our attention before the required date passes, rather than after, so we can appropriately assess the situation and provide relaxation of the requirements of the Order, as appropriate.
