

<p>Not to exceed quantity authorized under IW016 (and subsequent amendments).</p>	<p>The material to be exported to the Laguna Verde Nuclear Power Station (Laguna Verde) in Veracruz, Mexico is secondary Class A radioactive waste resulting from the dissolving and decontamination of polyvinyl alcohol (PVA) dissolvable protective clothing, process filters, and related items (e.g., zippers and elastic) originally imported from Laguna Verde under NRC import license IW016 (and subsequent amendments). Following processing at the Eastern Technologies, Inc. (ETI) facility, the secondary waste will be either returned directly to Laguna Verde or shipped to a licensed third party waste processor for further volume reduction processing and returned to ETI for export back to Laguna Verde.</p> <p>This license is amended to extend the date of expiration from December 31, 2015 to December 31, 2020.</p> <p>All other conditions remain the same.</p> <p>//////////////////////////////////////END//////////////////////////////////////</p>
