I. SECY-15-0145 – NEXTERA ENERGY SEABROOK, LLC (SEABROOK STATION,
UNIT 1): MOTION TO WITHDRAW FINAL ENVIRONMENTAL IMPACT STATEMENT

The Commission approved a Memorandum and Order responding to a motion by Friends of the Coast and New England Coalition requesting the withdrawal, and re-issuance for public comment, of the Final Supplemental Environmental Impact Statement prepared for the Seabrook Station, Unit 1 license renewal application. The Memorandum and Order denies the motion.

II. SECY-16-0008 – SHINE MEDICAL TECHNOLOGIES, INC. (MEDICAL
RADIOISOTOPE PRODUCTION FACILITY), MANDATORY HEARING DECISION

The Commission approved a Memorandum and Order addressing the required findings and the issues discussed at the uncontested hearing concerning the application of SHINE Medical Technologies, Inc. to construct a medical radioisotope production facility in Janesville, Wisconsin. The Memorandum and Order authorizes issuance of the construction permit.
