Dear Mr. Sims,

I've reviewed your exempt distribution report dated January 5, 2016 for the 2015 reporting period.

Please revise and resubmit your report to indicate the physical form of the products that you distributed. This request is based on the regulation in 10 CFR 32.20(c) that requires you to report, for each radionuclide in each physical form, the total quantity of each radionuclide *and the physical form* transferred under the specific license. Also, you should revise the second sentence of your report to indicate that the materials were transferred "for use under 10 CFR 30.18 or equivalent regulations of an Agreement State." This sentence currently refers to transfers of byproduct material "for use under 10 CFR 32.18" and this is incorrect. Further information about the requirements that apply to annual reports of exempt distribution can be found in the attached Regulatory Issue Summary.
