
**Amendment No. 20**

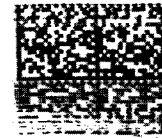
