I am responding to your February 5, 2016, letter to U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) Chairman Stephen G. Burns. You requested the NRC's input in developing the Susquehanna River Basin Commission's (SRBC) Water Resources Program for fiscal years (FY) 2017 through 2018. Specifically, you requested the NRC submit a completed FY 2017–2018 Water Resources Program input form by March 7, 2016.

As you know, in 2008, the NRC received a combined license application for the proposed Bell Bend Nuclear Power Plant, which would be located on the Bell Bend of the Susquehanna River in Luzerne County, PA. In a letter dated January 9, 2014, the applicant, Talen Energy, requested that the NRC place the safety review portion of the combined license application on hold until further notice. The main focus for Talen Energy will be to support the necessary work leading to the issuance of a final environmental impact statement. The three operating nuclear power plants located within the Susquehanna River Basin do not have any active licensing activities before the NRC that may affect surface water or ground water from the river.

The NRC has completed the FY 2016–2017 Water Resources Program input form and enclosed it with this letter. Specifically, the agency has added information to the Priority Management Area F of the FY 2016–2017 Water Resources Program input form.
