By letter dated January 19, 2016 (ML16020A218), staff issued Certificate of Compliance (CoC) No. 9212, Revision No. 9, for the Model No. RH-TRU 72-B package. Due to an inadvertent error, staff is reissuing the CoC as Revision No. 10. Changes made to the enclosed certificate are indicated by vertical lines in the margin. The staff's safety evaluation report is also enclosed.

This approval constitutes authority to use the package for shipment of radioactive material and for the package to be shipped in accordance with the provisions of 49 CFR 173.471. Registered users of the package under the general license provisions of 10 CFR 71.17 or 49 CFR 173.471 have been provided a copy of this certificate.

EVALUATION

By letter dated January 19, 2016 (ML16020A218), staff issued Certificate of Compliance (CoC) No. 9212, Revision No. 9, for the Model No. RH-TRU 72-B package. Due to an inadvertent error, staff is reissuing the CoC as Rev. 10. Staff inadvertently skipped a revision number of the CoC by issuing Rev. 9 as opposed to Rev. 8. Rev. 9 of the CoC contains a statement which refers to the non-existent Rev. 8 of the CoC. Therefore, staff decided to reissue the CoC as Rev. 10 and remove the condition which references Rev. 8.

Specifically, staff removed Condition No. 13, which previously stated, "Revision No. 8 of this certificate may be used until January 31, 2017." As this condition refers to the nonexistent Rev. 8 of the CoC, it has been deleted. Staff contacted the applicant and confirmed that any projected shipments up to January 31, 2017, would not be affected by the deletion of this condition.

Staff agrees that the changes do not affect the ability of the packages to meet the requirements of 10 CFR Part 71.

CONDITIONS

The following updates have been made to the CoC:

Condition No. 13, which previously stated, "Revision No. 8 of this certificate may be used until January 31, 2017," has been deleted.

The previous Condition No. 14 is now Condition No. 13.

The previous Condition No. 15 is now Condition No. 14.

CONCLUSION

The staff concludes that the changes indicated do not affect the ability of the package to meet the requirements of 10 CFR Part 71.
