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## Submitter Information

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## General Comment

Nuclear power plants, whether operating or permanently closed, are potentially dangerous and require close monitoring. Regulations regarding the decommissioning of power reactors need to be improved as follows:

- 1) the decommissioning funds must be used exclusively for radiological cleanup, not operating expenses or lobbying,
- 2) the parent corporations must not be allowed to escape responsibility for financial shortfalls in the decommissioning fund, and 3) Emergency Planning Zones should not be diminished, nor insurance coverage reduced, until all the spent fuel rods have been removed from the highly vulnerable spent fuel pools and put into safer dry cask storage.
