Dear Mr. Gardner:

By letter dated September 29, 2015, Northern States Power Company, doing business as Xcel Energy, submitted an application for an exemption request for nonconforming dry shielded canister dye penetrant examinations.

The staff has determined that further information is needed to complete its technical review. The request for additional information (RAI) is in the enclosure. Your response should be provided by March 15, 2016. If you are unable to meet this deadline, please notify us in writing, at least one week in advance, of your new submittal date and the reasons for the delay. The staff will then assess the impact of the new submittal date and notify you of a revised schedule. We have developed an updated schedule based on the need for a 2nd round of RAIs as follows.
