Good morning. I found your name listed on the USFWS website for Field Office Contact Information for Project Reviews and S7 Consultations. I am working on an environmental assessment for the license termination of the Zion Nuclear Power station (ZNPS) in Lake County, IL. The ZNPS site borders the Illinois Beach State Park on both the north and south sides, and Lake Michigan on the east. The Wildlife Habitat Council conducted a survey of the site in 2005 and presented wildlife management opportunities, but at that time did not identify any federal or state T& E species.
