Ron Burrows just sent me his response to your questions dated 3/4/16. Just wanted to clear up something you mentioned in your email. You wrote "According to David Miesbach, NDEQ does not have records of premining arsenic levels." I checked my emails to you and did not see where I said that, and I hope I didn't mislead you in any of our telephone conversations. Arsenic is one of the baseline parameters for groundwater that Crow Butte is required to collect. You should be able to view that data in any of the initial Notice of Intents (NOIs) for all the Mine Units. Thanks.
