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Dear Mr. Preston,

I've reviewed your exempt distribution report dated January 26, 2016 for the 2015 reporting period. Some changes to your report are necessary so that it meets the reporting requirements for your license.

Your report is a bit of a jumble concerning regulatory references. Our regulations as they apply to your license and the way in which we wrote Condition 9 of your license is admittedly complicated. To start, I point out that your license authorizes main two things:

- Distribution under 10 CFR 32.14 of ionizing radiation measuring instruments containing Cs-137 for purposes of internal calibration or standardization for use under 10 CFR 30.15(a)(9).
- Distribution under 10 CFR 32.18 of licensed material as specified in 30.71, Schedule B, in the form of calibration sources for use under 10 CFR 30.18.

The two paragraphs of your report should be revised so that they reflect these two separate authorizations.

Specifically, in the first paragraph of your report, you should remove the reference to 32.14 and add this statement: "These products are transferred for use under 10 CFR 30.18 or equivalent regulations of an Agreement State."

In the second paragraph of your report, you should delete the words "Pursuant to sections 30.15 and 30.18, 10 CFR Part 30" and replace them with "Pursuant to 10 CFR 32.14" and add this sentence: "The products are transferred for use under 10 CFR 30.15(a)(9)." [I add that it does not appear from your license that you are authorized under 10 CFR 32.14 to distribute ionizing radiation measuring instruments containing manganese-54.]

Further information about the requirements that apply to annual reports of exempt distribution can be found in the attached Regulatory Issue Summary.
