Dear Ms. Rivera:

The Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) indicated a need to review the conclusions in the Interim Findings Report (IFR) for Planning dated February 17, 2010, for the Levy Nuclear Plant (LNP) Units 1 and 2 Combined License (COL). FEMA felt that the decommissioning of Crystal River Unit 3 and the potential for its impact on the original findings regarding adequacy of off-site capabilities necessitated this review.

FEMA Region IV has completed a review of the latest revision of the application for the LNP. They determined that the planning commitment letters from the State of Florida and counties of Levy, Marion and Citrus which were also included in the original application provide an adequate planning framework for LNP. Since these letters were included in the original application material there is no need to revise the original Interim Finding Report for Planning dated December 17, 2010. These letters provide the necessary assurances that the protection of the health and safety of off-site populations will be maintained. FEMA Headquarters concurs with the FEMA Region IV findings.
