The Commission was briefed by the NRC staff on strategic considerations associated with the Nuclear Materials Users and the Fuel Facilities Business Lines. Topics discussed from the Fuel Facilities Business Line included successes and challenges, Project Aim implementation, current fuel cycle program environment, fuel cycle oversight program accomplishments and challenges, and international safeguards. The Nuclear Materials Users Business Line's topics included successes and challenges, Project Aim implementation, overview of the National Materials Program, external factors and uncertainties, materials inspection program accomplishments and challenges, Part 37 implementation and assessment, and implementation of the Agreement State Program.

In providing the regional materials program consolidation evaluation to the Commission, the staff should provide the full history of the business line, including fact of life changes, events affecting workload such as issuance of orders for security of materials, and the addition of Agreement States, etc., and the resultant impact on resources.
