This refers to your application dated February 19, 2016, for renewal of NRC license numbers 19-00915-03 and 19-00915-06. In order to process your application, please submit the information for items 5 through 11, on NRC form 313, for each of the two licenses. Your reply must be in the form of an originally signed and dated letter. The letter may be scanned and submitted as a pdf document attached to an email, or it may be transmitted by facsimile to (610) 337-5269; or it may be sent by regular paper delivery (such as US mail) to the address on the NRC form 313.

Normal allowance of time to provide additional information is 30 calendar days from the date of the correspondence. In order to process this application in a timely manner we ask that you please provide the requested information no later than **April 9, 2016**.
