As an ESL teacher, I have had many Japanese students. Over the past five years, they have told me about the horrors of Fukushima and the ongoing attempts to make the area livable again. While I do not expect there to be a similar occurrence at Pilgrim, the idea that safety regulations would be lessened before all of the spent fuel rods currently in a wet pool are moved into dry cask storage is indefensible. Furthermore, we must make sure that Entergy is not allowed to raid the decommissioning fund to pay for other expenses. Indeed, we must make sure that Entergy adds money to the current fund so that they will be certain to be able to pay to clean and restore the site for future use. It would be unacceptable for the citizens of the Commonwealth to have to pay. Please make sure that the regulations of the NRC protect the citizens, both in terms of health and safety and economics rather than protecting the interests of companies like Entergy.
