Exelon Generation Company, LLC (EGC) has reviewed the existing NRC QAP Approval Form 311 for NRC Docket No. 71-0008 and concur that Zion Station should be removed, since the site now works under the ZionSolutions NRC-approved QAP.

However, as a point of information, within the next five years (approximately), the responsibility and license for the Zion facility, which at that time will only be an Independent Spent Fuel Storage Installation (ISFSI) under a site-specific license, will be transferred back to EGC. At that time, EGC will request reinstatement of the Zion facility to the NRC Form 311 for NRC Docket No. 71-0008.
