Confirmation of verbal contact made April 1, 2016: Monitor wells listed below in Wellfield J and 3 were scheduled to be sampled the last 3 days in March. Delays created by weather during the week prevented the timely sampling of these wells. Mine Unit J (MU-J) wells will be sampled Monday, April 4. Mine Unit 3 (MU-3) well will be sampled first week of April pending access. Monitor wells are sampled according to Permit 633, Operations Plan Section 8.2, at a frequency of twice per month not less than 10 days apart. This delayed sampling should mean all these wells will be sampled 3 times in April not less than 10 days apart. The sampling event will not be skipped but delayed. The total number of wells (42 from MU-J and one from MU-3) are outlined below.

None of these wells are near excursion status. The delayed sampling should have no impacts to the monitoring of these wellfields.

In accordance to the Permit 633, Section 8.2, a written notification will be submitted within 15 days (on or before April 15, 2016) to discuss any impacts from the delayed sampling. The event will also be described in the 2015-2016 Annual Report submitted on or before June 18, 2016 and in the Q1 Excursion Monitoring Report for 2016.
