SUBJECT: U.S. NUCLEAR REGULATORY COMMISSION ACTION IN  
RESPONSE TO THE MARCH 10, 2016, TELECONFERENCE  
MEETING OF THE ADVISORY COMMITTEE ON THE MEDICAL  
USES OF ISOTOPES

Below is the recommendation from the March 10, 2016, teleconference meeting of the Advisory Committee on the Medical Uses of Isotopes. Following the recommendation is the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) staff response and/or position.

**ITEM (1):** The Committee endorsed the Training and Experience Requirements of Authorized Users of Alpha, Beta and Gamma Emitters under 10 CFR 35.390 Subcommittee Report. This included a recommendation to (1) maintain the current 700 hours of training and experience (T&E) under §35.390; and (2) to establish a standing subcommittee with the specific charge of periodically reviewing the T&E requirements currently in effect and make recommendations for changes as warranted.

The recommendation passed unanimously with 11 favorable votes. The standing subcommittee was formed in February 2016. The NRC resource is Maryann Abogunde.
