## INSTRUCTIONS TO STUDENTS

**ACCEPTANCE:** This is to advise you that individuals listed in Enclosure 1 have been accepted for participation in the MARSAME: Multi-Agency Radiation Survey and Assessment of Materials and Equipment (H-120). This course is scheduled to be presented at the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission's (NRC's) Professional Development Center (PDC) June 13-16, 2016. The PDC is located at the 3 White Flint North Building which is situated across Marinelli Road from One White Flint North between the White Flint Metro station entrance and the Metro parking garage. The address for the building is 11601 Landsdown Street, North Bethesda, MD 20852. Please allow sufficient time to process through security upon arrival. You will be required to show proof of identification when you arrive. After you have processed through security, you will be escorted by an NRC employee to the 2<sup>nd</sup> floor where the training will be held.

**LODGING AND TRAVEL:** Please plan to arrive on Sunday, June 12, 2016, and depart on Thursday, June 16, 2016. Students must make their own lodging and travel arrangements. If traveling by air, please contact El Sol Travel at 844-244-6694 for airline reservations, and indicate that the travel is "Invitational" for the NRC. Please select a fully refundable Government fare if one is available, and make sure that El Sol Travel correctly direct bills your fare to credit card ending 2835. Flights may be converted to less costly, non-refundable tickets, so please select carefully. If the need arises and you must make a change, please contact Marcia Casby at (301) 415-6525.

Please complete the Travel Application Form which will be provided to you and submit to Marcia Casby, [ASTrainingandtravel.Resource@nrc.gov](mailto:ASTrainingandtravel.Resource@nrc.gov), at your earliest opportunity, but no later than Friday, April 15. Individuals should request the Federal government rate at the hotels. The per diem for North Bethesda, Maryland is \$226 hotel and \$69 meals and incidentals. No rental cars will be authorized for travel.
