General Comment

As we hear of more and more terrorist activity any transportation of highly radioactive waste material must be more carefully considered. Only transport casks that are approved by the NRC itself should be considered for transport of such waste.

Moving the highly radioactive waste should not be considered until a permanent storage place is found; moving it before such a place is found, i.e. moving it twice, would expose the public to great danger unnecessarily.

In view of the fact that a permanent is not yet found, and not likely to be found, the safest approach is to discontinue producing nuclear waste. Shut down and start decommissioning all nuclear power plants!
