Update for the Operations Security Plan for the American Centrifuge Operating, LLC

Dear Mr. Layton:

The purpose of this letter is to document a conference call discussion held on March 24, 2016, with staff from the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission, U.S. Department of Energy, and American Centrifuge Operating, LLC (ACO). The discussion was a follow-up to ACO's annual evaluation of the Piketon, Ohio, Operations Security (OPSEC) Plan submitted to the NRC by ACO letter ACO 15-0035. With the announcement of the decommissioning and license termination of the American Centrifuge Lead Cascade Facility in Piketon, ACO is in a period of change which potentially affects the existing Piketon OPSEC Plan. ACO committed to evaluate the need for Piketon OPSEC Plan adjustments during this period of transition. In addition, ACO stated that the eventual alignment of the other ACO locations and their respective OPSEC plans has not yet been determined. Until such determination is made, ACO will continue to follow the existing approved OPSEC Plans.
