Dave and John:

As we discussed this morning the Ross plant is shut down due to a failure in some production piping in the CPP that was caused by a power bump yesterday. We have not been able to maintain a bleed since that time but have identified a method to bypass the affected piping and resume enough production from Mine Unit 1 to resume our bleed. We expect that these modifications will be completed by later today or early tomorrow and we will resume a bleed at that time. We are working on identifying the requirements for full repairs to the plant but it currently appears they should be complete by the end of this week. I will keep you informed of any changes.
