Reference is made to the letter dated April 7, 2016 to the Nuclear Regulatory Commission (“NRC”) from Canberra Industries, Inc. (“Canberra U.S.”) and Mirion Technologies, Inc. (“Mirion”) jointly requesting the consent of the NRC to the indirect transfer of control of Materials License Numbers 06-15099-01 and 06-15099-03E from AREVA Inc. (“AREVA”) to Mirion in conjunction with the purchase and sale of the shares of Canberra U.S. from AREVA by Mirion (the “Request Letter”). Canberra U.S. hereby submits this supplement to the Request Letter in response to request for additional information from Mr. Dennis Lawyer of the NRC received by Canberra U.S. on April 21, 2016.

1. Mirion, a company organized under the laws of the State of Delaware, will purchase 100% of the outstanding shares of Canberra U.S. With respect to Canberra France, the specific plans for that acquisition have not yet been finalized, but the purchaser will be a French company wholly owned by Mirion Global. Canberra U.S. will provide a further update to the NRC with respect to the purchaser of Canberra France as soon as additional information becomes available.


