SUBJECT: SUMMARY OF THE OCTOBER 14, 2015, PUBLIC MEETING WITH
DOMINION VIRGINIA POWER TO DISCUSS NORTH ANNA
COMBINED LICENSE APPLICATION COLA TOPICS

On October 14, 2015, a Category 1 public meeting was held between the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) staff and Dominion Virginia Power (Dominion) regarding the North Anna Unit 3 Combined Operating License Application submitted on December 18, 2013.

The topics for discussion during this meeting included the "Follow-up Actions from NRC Audit 1 Updated 10/02/2015" (Agencywide Documents Access and Management System Accession No ML16124A992), along with discussions on NRC staff general questions and other general administrative issues related to the ongoing safety review of the North Anna 3 application.

The meeting commenced at approximately 2:00 p.m. with NRC staff opening remarks, an introduction of attendees, and an announcement of meeting logistics. The following issues were discussed:

- The staff feedback on the final safety analysis report (FSAR) text consistency with respect to Dominion's response to Request for Additional Information 02.04.02-15. The staff indicated that the FSAR was not consistent with respect to the definitions for the Maximum Flood Level, Design Basis Flood, and Local Intense Precipitation. The staff indicated that the application needed to clearly distinguish between the different events. Dominion would take a look into the issue and report back to the NRC staff during the next scheduled call.
