In letter dated April 6, 2016, you contacted the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission and indicated that you wished to terminate your NRC radioactive materials licenses. Based on the review of the information you provided, the staff has concluded that all licensable radioactive material has been removed from your facility and residual radioactive material attributable to licensed activities does not exceed current NRC criteria.



An environmental assessment for this action is not required, since this action is categorically excluded under 10 CFR 51.22(c) (20) (iii).
