Gentlemen:

The purpose of this letter is to supplement a proposed amendment I submitted on May 7, 1991 and supplemented on May 13, 1991 and August 1, 1991, concerning the Oconee Nuclear Station (ONS) facility operating licenses and revisions to the ONS Technical Specifications (TS). The proposed amendment consisted of changes to support operation of unit 1 at full power during Cycle 14 and future fuel cycle designs for all Oconee units.

The supplemental information provided in the attachment to this letter was requested by the NRC staff during a conference call on August 8, 1991. The following is a summary of the contents of this supplement.

1. Figures 1.1 and 1.2, located in the CORE OPERATING LIMITS REPORT (COLR) in the May 7th submittal have been returned to TS as Figures 2.1-1 and 2.1-2 respectively. All references made in the previous submittal to these figures have been changed to indicate that they are located in TS instead of the COLR.
2. The figures names have been changed to agree with the references in the specification.

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
