SUBJECT: PRIMARY TO SECONDARY STEAM GENERATOR LEAK

The licensee declared an Unusual Event at 1:15 a.m. (EDT) on April 18, 1988, after confirming a 1.35 gpm leak in the A steam generator.

The steam generator leakage was detected when the reading on the condenser air ejector exhaust monitor increased significantly. A reactor shutdown began immediately. The unit is currently shutdown and cooling down to repair and perform tests on the steam generators.

There were no releases to the atmosphere. All systems functioned normally during the shutdown.

The licensee estimates the unit will be shut down for ten days.

The State of South Carolina has been informed.

The licensee is issuing a news release.
