LONG TERM SURVEILLANCE PLAN FOR THE MAYBELL, COLORADO,  
DISPOSAL SITE (DOCKET NUMBER: WM-69)

Dear Mr. Nguyen:

I am writing in response to the U.S. Department of Energy's (DOE's) request for the Nuclear Regulatory Commission's (NRC's) acceptance of the revised Long Term Surveillance Plan (LTSP) for the Maybell, Colorado, Uranium Mill Tailings Radiation Control Act site, dated April 11, 2008 (Agencywide Document Access and Management System (ADAMS) Accession Number ML081080326). The revised LTSP corrects the site boundary shown on Figure 2-3 and replaces the November 2007 version of the LTSP (ML073510293). The November 2007 version incorporated the discontinuance of the best management practice ground water level monitoring program that was approved by the NRC on January 5, 2005 (ML050050542). After reviewing records for the site, we were unable to locate the NRC's acceptance of the November 2007 version of the LTSP, and therefore we reviewed both the November 2007 and April 2008 versions of the LTSP to determine if the revisions are acceptable. Based on our reviews, the NRC staff does not have any comments or questions on either version of the LTSP at this time. Therefore, the April 2008 version of the LTSP will be the applicable LTSP for the Maybell site.
