In your e-mail dated May 9, 2016, to the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC), you requested to withdraw your pending export license application XCOM1288. In response to your e-mail, the NRC is returning the application to Technetics Group Columbia without action.

License application XCOM1288 requested the export of multiple sets of reactor pressure vessel seal sets, clips and screws to China for use at the CNNC Liaoning Nuclear Power Plant.

As the NRC had already begun processing and reviewing the application, we cannot refund the \$9,800 licensing fee that Technetics Group Columbia submitted to the NRC on September 11, 2014.
