Dear Senator Markey:

I am providing a second response to your February 17, 2016, letter to the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) requesting documents regarding the Seabrook Station Unit 1.

Enclosed is Revision 16 for Seabrook's Updated Final Safety Analysis Report (UFSAR). Two versions of the report, redacted and unredacted, are provided. The two CDs that are marked for public release contain redacted pages. The NRC plans to make this information publicly available. The other two CDs are marked "Not for Public Release" because they contain security-related information, which the NRC is withholding from public release under 5 USC Sections 552(b)(4) and 552(b)(7)(F). We request that these documents be held in confidence with access limited to members and committee staff. Once our review of the earlier versions of Seabrook's UFSAR is completed, we will provide you with copies, as you requested.

Also, enclosed is a copy of a portion of the December 3, 2015, response from NextEra Energy Seabrook, LLC (NextEra) to the NRC staff's request for additional information "SET 25" on issues relating to the requested renewal of the Seabrook operating license. Specifically, NextEra's letter and Enclosures 3-6 are being provided, as well as Enclosure 2, which was submitted by NextEra as a redacted version of Enclosure 1. NextEra's Enclosure 1 and unredacted Enclosure 2 are not included because they contain trade secrets and proprietary information belonging to NextEra that are protected from disclosure under 18 USC Section 1905 and 5 USC Section 552(b)(4).
