Dear Mr. Little:

The Atomic Energy Commission has submitted to the Office of the Federal Register for filing and publication a notice relating to the proposed issuance of a facility operating license which would authorize the Duke Power Company to possess, use, and operate the Oconee Nuclear Station Unit 1, a pressurized water type nuclear reactor, on the applicant's site in eastern Oconee County, South Carolina.

The reactor is capable of operation at a power level of 2568 megawatts thermal. Initially, the maximum power level will be restricted to 2452 megawatts thermal. Later, as set forth in the enclosed notice, the facility will be authorized to operate at steady state power levels not to exceed 2568 megawatts thermal.

Copies of the notice and the proposed operating license are enclosed for your information. Copies of a related safety evaluation prepared by the Division of Reactor Licensing and an environmental Statement referred to in the notice will be sent to you as soon as they become available.
