
MEMORANDUM AND ORDER  
(Request for An Extension of Time)

On March 25, 1999, Cabot Performance Materials (Licensee) filed a "Second Unopposed Motion for Additional Extension of Time to Respond To Requests for a Hearing of (1) Redevelopment Authority of Reading and City of Reading and (2) Jobert Inc. and Metals Trucking, Inc." Licensee explained that the extension until July 15, 1999, which is subject to conditions set forth in the motion, is requested because:

(1) additional time is required to collect further technical and other information regarding the Reading site; (2) such information would be obtained and shared among the Requestors and the Licensee; (3) collection of such information should assist in resolving the concerns of the Requestors with the site Decommissioning Plan; and (4) a further extension of time until July 15, 1999 for Licensee's Answers to the Requests for Hearing is warranted.

In order to facilitate settlement in this case, pursuant to 10 C.F.R. § 2.1241, the motion is *granted*.
