By a letter dated September 20, 1990, the NRC was advised of our efforts to improve for each station our submittals provided in response to Generic Letter 88-14 . An action plan to accomplish this task was discussed within the September 20, 1990 letter. By January 15, 1991, schedular information regarding the implementation and completion of the plan was to be provided to you.

The purpose of this letter is to advise you of a delay in providing this information. I anticipate being able to provide this information to you by no later than March 5, 1991.

further, by a letter dated May 8, 1989, our initial response to the Generic Letter for Oconee Nuclear Station was submitted. Within the May 8, 1989 letter, several actions to enhance the overall performance of the Instrument Air System at Oconee were identified. Three of these actions are as follows:

- 1) Establish a PM program for critical instrument air demand equipment to ensure that regulator filter elements are replaced on a three year frequency on every other outage. This program was scheduled to be complete by January 1991.
- 2) Replace the regulator filter elements for the equipment identified critical to operation. The replacement of these filter elements was scheduled to be completed by January 1991.
- 3) Add 3 small, non-load shed, compressors, after coolers, desiccant dryers and filters to support the operation of certain critical valves and instruments. This system was scheduled to be operational by December 1990.

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
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The schedule for completing the above three commitments have been revised. The new schedule for completing the above three actions for Ocone are as follows:

- 1) For Unit 1: February 1992
For Unit 2: March 1992
For Unit 3: July 1991
- 2) For Unit 1: End of Cycle 13
For Unit 2: End of Cycle 12
For Unit 3: End of Cycle 12
- 3) For Unit 1: End of Cycle 13
For Unit 2: End of Cycle 12
For Unit 3: End of Cycle 13
