Station Blackout Revised Response

By a letter dated March 10, 1992, the NRC provided a Safety Evaluation (SE) for Duke Power Company's responses to the Station Blackout Rule (SBO) for the Oconee Nuclear Site Units 1, 2, and 3. The SE provided recommendations and also contained a request for additional information. Additionally, the SE requested that a revised SBO response be submitted within sixty days of the receipt of the SE.

This letter is to document a request for additional time to submit a revised response. The reasoning for this request is to allow additional time to assemble the information to evaluate revision alternatives. Additionally, a meeting between Duke Power Company and the NRR is planned to discuss Duke's response prior to submittal.
